



Moraine Point Plaza PNC Branch Bank



This large PNC Branch was built in southern Butler County to serve an enlarging and growing North Hills population. The project includes a number of teller stations and platform spaces as well as a drive thru banking operation. Because the building was physically below the adjacent highway, a large tower was raised in the center of the plan to announce the PNC branch to north and south traffic along the nearby arterial highway.

Other branch banks designed by Celli-Flynn Brennan would include the original Mellon Branch in the lobby level of One Mellon Bank Center, the National City Branch in Millcraft Center in Washington, PA, and the new PNC Pleasant Hills branch.
