



DiSepio Institute for Rural Health and Wellness | Loretto, PA



The DiSepio Institute for Rural Health and Wellness is being developed to support St. Francis University's expanding academic programs and to address rural health care issues and initiatives. The 3 story, 30,000 square foot building is the first phase of a larger science and wellness complex and will include an education and research center, student health clinic, rehabilitation center, therapy pool, cardio-theater, strength training, biomechanics lab., cardio-vascular metabolic lab., aerobics classroom and a video-conferencing/symposium room. St. Francis, located in Loretto, PA, offers programs in physical therapy, physician assistant science, occupational therapy, pre-medicine, pharmacy, nursing and exercise physiology. The \$7 million dollar institute will also serve Cambria County and the state by enabling the University's Center for Emergency Response in Medically Underserved Areas (CER-MUSA) to have on-site testing of new technology and methodologies for delivery of health care to those in rural America
